Beyond the Curriculum: MARLING DIAMOND PROGRAMME

Our aim in Marling Sixth Form is to enable students to develop a range of academic and broader skills that prepare them for their next step, whether that is a university degree; Music, Drama or Art College; an apprenticeship or employment.

Students choose an academic programme of study based around three or four A-levels. In addition, students choose a Breadth Option and follow the Marling Diamond Programme, which brings together multiple curriculum and Beyond the Curriculum activities to demonstrate the range of skills and achievements that modern academic institutions and employers are looking for.

Sixth Formers complete their personalised Marling Diamond Programme throughout Y12, taking up at least 6 opportunities and demonstrating a minimum of 2 skills in each of the four AIMS strands. Successful completion of the programme forms a mandatory part of application for Wednesday afternoon home study in Y13.



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These are some of the opportunities currently available to our sixth form students as part of the Marling Diamond Programme. The list is not exhaustive, as new clubs and societies can be established throughout the year, and students are also able to nominate additional activities that allow them to demonstrate Marling Diamond skills.
