



GCSE Results Day – Thursday 20th August 2020

You need to collect your GCSE results on Thursday 20th August in Marling Dining Hall. You will be advised ahead of results day about the time that you should collect your results. This will either be a 9:00am or 9:30am timeslot. Remember if you are not available to collect them in person you must have submitted **prior written confirmation** to the school naming the person who will collect them on your behalf. **This person must bring ID with them on the day** before your results will be passed to them.

We hope that you continue your studies at Marling Sixth Form. All students must complete a blue form contained in your results envelope before you leave school on Results Day, or by 4pm at the very latest on the 20th August if you are not collecting your results in person. Failure to do so may affect your course choices in the Sixth Form in the event of over-subscription.
