Beyond the Curriculum: MARLING DIAMOND PROGRAMME

Our aim in Marling Sixth Form is to enable students to develop a range of academic and broader skills that prepare them for their next step, whether that is a university degree; Music, Drama or Art College; an apprenticeship or employment.

Students choose an academic programme of study based around three or four A Levels. In addition, Y12 students follow the Marling Diamond Programme, which brings together Breadth Options and multiple super-curriculum and extra-curricular activities to demonstrate the range of skills and achievements that modern academic institutions and employers are looking for.
