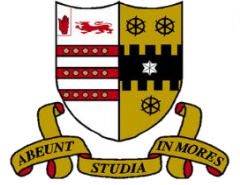

Also check your google classrooms for extra resources, such as essay planning devices.</p>	Conversation with your relevant Politics teacher.
<p>Check what type of questions you could be asked on these topic areas to make sure that you have the depth of knowledge, and also know what your opinion on the topics are, e.g. Should the UK adopt a codified constitution?</p>	120 mins	<p>Make sure that you plan out answers to the topics using flash cards or diagrams to know your opinion clearly on the topics.
